

## TOP TEN Alaskan Malamute – Competition Rules

This is a competition for the title of the most successful Alaskan Malamute – male and female.

- 1) Any Alaskan Malamutes registered in FCI recognized stud books can take part in the competition.
- 2) Competing male or female must be owned by a regular member of AMKCR.
- 3) Males and females are competing separately.
- 4) Only points earned from shows organized by FCI recognized entities count.
- 5) The competition runs every calendar year, i.e. from 1<sup>st</sup> of January to 31<sup>st</sup> of December of that particular year.
- 6) Owners of the registered dogs should send the show results (copies) to one of the addresses below and should do so continuously during the whole year.
- 7) The results have to be submitted continuously, as the rankings are getting published regularly in the bulletin and on the club website.
- 8) The final deadline for submitting the last show results is 31<sup>st</sup> of January of the following year.
- 9) The ranking of top ten males and top ten females is published in the bulletin and on the AMKCR website.
- 10) Members that want to take part in the competition should send in a filled-in registration form together with a copy of their dog's pedigree by post or by e-mail, **31<sup>st</sup> January of the year they want to participate in the latest.** (The registration form can be found on [www.amkcr.eu](http://www.amkcr.eu) or we can send it to you on request).
- 11) The point rating of various placings and acquired titles can be found in the table.
